ERRATUM to Table 4.

Due to a wrong formatation of the table-columns the figures for pheasants (12 million individuals) and woodpigeons (7 million ind.) hunted in the U.K. are missing in table 4.

Due to a misprint in the original source (ROBINSON 2005) the number of jays shot in the UK is lower than stated in table 4. Referring to the mean of killed individuals per km² given by ROBINSON (2005) the actual estimation for the UK is 73.800 killed individuals per season. Following this correction the estimation of the total number of jays shot in the EU (Tables 3 and 4) is corrected to 480.388 killed individuals per season.
